

English


This term in English we will be working on the text 'The Jungle Book' and 'Walking through the Jungle'. As part of this we will be retelling the story and writing descriptions of the characters and the settings from the story.

After half term, our new topic will be Journeys and New Places where we will look at texts such as 'Meerkat Mail' and 'Tuesday'. We will also be looking at sorties linked to Diwali, The Gunpowder plot and The Nativity.

In Guided Reading we will be working with a selection of fiction and non-fiction texts. As part of this we will be completing reading activities to support the understanding of the texts we have read.



Mathematics





We will be working with different sized 2D shapes through recognising them and naming them in different orientations. We will use these to make different patterns and pictures. Through discussion we will be able to use language to describe them and begin to describe some properties of 3D shapes.

During our measures work we will be using standard and non-standard units to compare, describe and measure different weights, heights and lengths. Throughout our Numeracy lessons we will be applying our new skills to different problem solving activities.

Science

In science we will be learning about different types of weather and how weather affects humans and animals. We will also be learning about the different parts of our bodies and how we use our five senses.

History:

In History we will be learning about the Gunpowder Plot, the key events and the main people involved.

Geography:

In Geography we will be looking at hot and cold countries and how animals adapt to their climate.

D&T /Art/Music:

In D&T we will be investigating and building constructions. We will also be evaluating and improving our work.

MFL:

In French we will be looking at the differences between our cultures and countries. We will be discussing the different ways to travel there and our own experiences. We will of course be learning some basic conversational French as we go!

Computing:

In Computing we will be looking at a range of programs and learning how to use these correctly.

RE:

As part of Religious Education we will be learning about Harvest, Diwali and Christmas.

P.E./Games

In PE we will be learning new skills in throwing and catching, gymnastics and racket games.

PSHE:

In PSHE we will be exploring how to solve conflict, manage our feelings and get along with others .
