Accessing their learning environment and resources independently to create an independent, confident learner.



Prime areas :
Building relationships

Specific Areas:

- Hearing and writing initial sounds in simple words.
- Start forming initial sounds correctly.
- Practice writing their full name
- Listening to and continuing rhyming strings
- Recognising and writing numerals to 10
- Beginning to count to 10
- Recognise and explore 2D shapes..



Outdoor and Continuous Provision

We will be exploring our outdoor environment and investigating the different change in seasons. We will be developing our physical development skills through climbing, jumping, balancing and using PE equipment.

We love to take our learning outdoors as often as we can so we may get muddy! Therefore can you ensure your child has spare clothes in their bags incase of any muddy situations.

How you can help at home:

- Please send your child with a piece of fruit or vegetable every day for snack time.

- Count forwards and backwards to 10.
- Look at shapes in the environment and talk about their properties.
