English

This half term, Year 4 will be looking at the text 'Mars Needs Moms' as part of our Alien Invasion topic and the texts 'Gregory Cool', 'Hue Boy' and 'Colours of Home' as part of our stories from other cultures theme.

The skills that the children will be working on are: use of paragraphs to organise ideas around a theme; including subordinating conjunctions to add extra detail to their writing; the use of figurative language and writing a range of sentence types using ambitious vocabulary.

Mathematics

This half term, Year 4 will be working on number and place value, which involves ordering, comparing and rounding; addition and subtraction; properties of 2D shape; symmetry and statistics (including bar charts and tables).



There will be a focus on learning multiplication tables through chanting and rapid recall activities. We'd value your support with this.

The children will continue to work on their arithmetic skills which will include the four operations and fractions.

Science

This half term, the children will be exploring the digestive system and how the human body works. In addition to this, the children will be investigating with sound- how it is made and how it travels.

History:

The children will be investigating the Tudor period, looking at the monarchs, their lifestyles, buildings and clothing.

Geography:

Geography will involve looking at the continents with a focus on Europe and general place knowledge.

D&T /Art/Music:

Music lessons will focus on playing the ukulele and learning Christmas songs.

In art, your children will be recreating images in the style of Keith Haring.

MFL:

The children will be continuing to learn French, the focus this year will be on transport, building and special places.

Computing :

In Year 4 we will be working with digital animation and digital programming.

RE:

RE will involve exploring Christianity, including it's festivals and traditions.

P.E./Games

The children will be enjoying basket ball, dance, net ball and gymnastics. Our PE lessons will take place on a Monday. Please ensure your child has their kit in school on this day.

PSHE:

In PSHE we will be looking at the topics New Beginnings, It's Good to be Me, Getting on and Falling out and also focusing on anti-bullying.

As part of our Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural curriculum we will continue to interweave our school motto and core values into everything we do.
