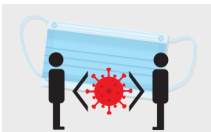


Let's continue to keep each other safe– Covid Support Advisors

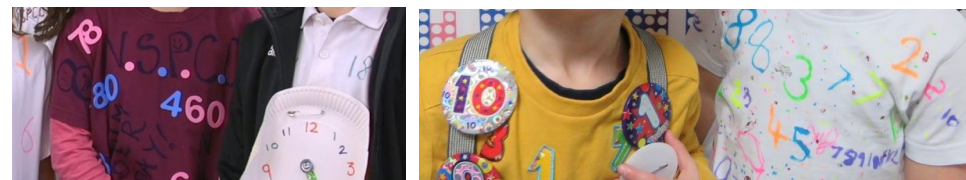
Friday 30th April—Awareness Raising Day— Limb Loss Awareness Month 2021
