Dear parents/carers,

As you are aware, a number of our Year 6 pupils will be visiting Laches Wood from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January to Friday 21<sup>st</sup> January. With this date approaching fast, we wanted to finalise details with you to allow for a smooth departure from school on the Monday.

Due to the current COVID 19 restrictions, we are asking that all children attending Laches Wood take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test on the morning of Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January. Once your child has received a negative result, please report this through the National Government Website: <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result> . Once you have received your negative LFD confirmation email, please forward this as proof to the Year 6 Team at [y6.homelearning@perryhallmat.co.uk](mailto:y6.homelearning@perryhallmat.co.uk) by **no later than 9.00am**.

In line with our current COVID 19 policy, all staff attending Laches Wood will be testing using a LFD before they arrive in school on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January and will continue to test throughout the week as usual.

Thank you to those who have already sent back the Laches Wood medical form. For any outstanding medical forms, please make sure that they are returned to your child's class teacher **no later than Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January**.

If your child requires medication throughout the week, you will need to complete a 'medicine administration form' so that our first aider can provide medicine that has been prescribed by a doctor. **We will only be able to provide the children with medication that comes with a prescription.** Please speak to your child's class teacher to arrange a time to complete this form ahead of Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January if necessary.

The children will be travelling by coach to Laches Wood which will be departing at 10.00am on Monday. At the end of the week, the children will be back in school where you will be able to **collect them from their usual exit point at 3.00pm**.

It has been fantastic to see so many of our Year 6 pupils return to school this week eager to get started and looking forward to this year's residential trip. Thank you for your continued support with organising this valuable and memorable experience.
