

### **Covid Updates.**

As you are probably already aware, from Tuesday, 11th January, in England, people who receive positive lateral flow device (LFD) test results for coronavirus (COVID-19) are required to self-

isolate immediately and won't be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. This is a temporary measure while COVID-19 rates remain high across the UK. Whilst levels of COVID-19 are high, the vast majority of people with positive LFD results can be confident that they have COVID-19. Lateral flow tests are taken by people who do not have COVID-19 symptoms.

Anyone who develops 1 of the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms should stay at home and self-isolate and take a PCR test. You must self-isolate if you get a positive test result, even if you have had a recent negative lateral flow test – these rules have not changed.

We are awaiting the release of the full guidance regarding the further reduction of isolation periods. cover in each subject area to enable you to further support your child from home should you wish. This document will also provide you with a reminder of key year group information. A


